On February 25, 2019, Scheid Vineyards and the Prosecution Team jointly requested postponement of this hearing pending completion of settlement negotiations. On February 25, 2019, Hearing Officer E. Joaquin Esquivel granted the request for postponement. As of February 26, 2019, the settlement negotiation is complete, and the settlement agreement is pending the approval of the State Water Resources Control Board's Executive Director.


