PLEASE TAKE NOTICE

The Redwood Park Community Services District Hearing scheduled to commence on March 10, 2017, identified in the January 27, 2017 [Notice of Public Hearing](#) is cancelled.

The State Water Resources Control Board scheduled a hearing: 1) to receive evidence relevant to determining whether Redwood Park C S D violated regulations or the terms or conditions of any permit or license requiring the filing of a Progress Report by Permittee or Report of Licensee (collectively, Annual Water Use Report); and 2) if a violation occurred, to determine the amount of administrative civil liability and adopt an order imposing civil liability upon the Respondent.

Redwood Park C S D and the Board's Division of Water Rights' Prosecution Team requested postponement of the hearing and entered into a settlement agreement on February 28, 2017. By [Notice of Postponement of Public Hearing](#), dated February 28, 2017, the State Water Board postponed the March 10th hearing. On March 2, 2017, the State Water Board's Executive Director issued Water Right Order [WR 2017-0005-EXEC](#) (Order Approving Settlement Agreement). Accordingly, no hearing is required to be held on this matter and the previously scheduled hearing is **cancelled**.


