Project Description:

The purpose of the proposed Project is to upgrade three driveway road crossings and restore a drainage section.

The proposed project activities include:

- Constructing new concrete headwalls on the up and downstream sides of three existing culverts (Culvert 1, Culvert 2, and Culvert 3);
- Recontouring the existing channels (Tributary A and Tributary B) that flow through Culverts 1, 2, and 3 to provide 2:1 side slopes and modified bed slopes;
- Constructing a 2-foot wide gravel drainage swale to discharge to Tributary A;
- Replacing Culvert 2 with two 36-inch, 28-foot-long culverts;
- Replacing Culvert 3 with two 30-inch, 31-foot-long culverts; and
- Installing a 24-inch catch basin in the property driveway that discharges into Culvert 3.

Mitigation activities include:

- Permittee-responsible re-establishment of 0.16 acres / 206 linear feet of stream channel habitat; and
- Permittee-responsible establishment of 0.1 acres / 97 linear feet of riparian habitat.
