RESOLUTION NO. 70-35

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE
AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES
CONTROL BOARD AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF WATER
RESOURCES FOR ASSISTANCE IN PREPARATION
OF WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

WHEREAS, the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act and Title 18, Chapter V of Public Law 660 require the State Board to prepare state-wide water quality management plans, and

WHEREAS, the scope of the planning requires expertise in matters concerning the total water resource, hydrologic description of basins and regional areas, land-use and population projections, and water resources development, and


WHEREAS, the Department of Water Resources indicates that personnel can be made available on a contractual basis to assist the State Board in the functions of coordination and plan preparation; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorize the Executive Officer to execute an agreement with the State Department of Water Resources for assistance in the preparation of statewide water quality management plans; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement between the State Board and the Department of Water Resources shall be applicable for the period of approximately December 1, 1970 to June 30, 1971, and shall not exceed an amount of \$68,000.
