Resolution No. 73-5

ADOPTION OF PRIORITY LIST ASSIGNING 1972-73 PROJECTS  
TO A PRIORITY GROUP AND SPECIFYING ELIGIBILITY OF  
PRIORITY GROUPS FOR FISCAL YEAR 1972-73

WHEREAS:

1. Title 23, California Administrative Code, Chapter 3, Subchapter 7, Section 2122 requires that the State Board assign 1972-73 Clean Water Grant Projects to a priority group, and also provides that such priority groups be divided into two sections, the first section to be considered as eligible for grants during fiscal year 1972-73.
2. The State Water Resources Control Board has conducted a public hearing concerning the assignment of projects to specific priority groups and concerning the appropriate dividing point for the two sections involved, and has received and considered evidence relative thereto.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Each project designated on the priority list attached hereto, which said priority list is designated as "Exhibit A" and which is incorporated herein by reference, is assigned to the project group specified in "Exhibit A".
2. Priority Groups A, B, and C as set forth in "Exhibit A" are hereby designated as the first section of priority groups for fiscal year 1972-73, and will be considered as eligible for grants in fiscal year 1972-73.
3. The priority listing herein adopted (including estimated cost) may be subject to any changes in Administrative Code Section 2144 adopted on or before March 1, 1973.
