STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 73-19

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO STANDARD AGREEMENT NO. 2-2-65 WITH THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, DIVISION OF AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES, FOR PREPARATION OF COMPENDIUM ON EFFICIENCY OF IRRIGATION WATER USE IN CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Board's basin planning program incorporates appropriate control of irrigation return water as it affects the waters of the State.
- 2. Irrigated agriculture uses more water in California than all other uses combined.
- 3. The quality and quantity of irrigation return flows may be affected by the efficiency of irrigation.
- 4. The State Board has a need to understand what agricultural practices are being followed, how they affect efficiency and the quality of return flows.
- 5. The University of California, Division of Agricultural Sciences, has expertise in identification of agricultural practices, their affect on irrigation efficiency and their affect on the quality of irrigation return flows.
- 6. The University Committee of Consultants has expressed a desire to conduct a study and prepare a compendium on efficiency of water use for irrigation in California.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. That the Board amend its existing Standard Agreement No. 2-2-65 with the University of California, Division of Agricultural Sciences, to prepare a compendium on efficiency of water use for irrigation in California during the period April 19, 1973, through August 31, 1973, at a cost not to exceed \$4,000 of Clean Water Bond Funds.
- 2. That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, be authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board.
