RESOLUTION NO. 75-112

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COOPERATIVE  
AGREEMENT WITH U. S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY  
FOR REGIONAL BOARD CONTRACTUAL STUDIES

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board and the U. S. Geological Survey have the following studies continuing under the cooperative agreement program: (1) Santa Maria Groundwater Quality Study, (2) Barstow Area Groundwater Quality Monitoring, (3) Water-Quality Monitoring of Goose Lake, and (4) Copper Toxicity of Water in Tributaries to the Upper Sacramento River.
2. The State Board desires the studies to continue through F. Y. 1975-76.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board's Executive Officer, or Deputy Executive Officer, be authorized to execute an agreement with the U. S. Geological Survey for the conduct of cooperative studies in F. Y. 1975-76, in an amount not to exceed \$56,750 of Clean Water Bond Funds and \$8,975 of General Funds, subject to availability of federal matching funds.
2. The Regional Boards are directed to identify project officers for the respective projects and to report to the State Board on progress of the studies, including whether the work is satisfactory. The Regional Board progress reports are to be submitted quarterly for the Santa Maria Groundwater Quality Study and the Copper Toxicity of Water in Tributaries to the Upper Sacramento River and annually for the Barstow Area Groundwater Quality Monitoring and Water-Quality Monitoring of Goose Lake. By May 15, 1976, each Regional Board is to recommend whether the study should continue into the next fiscal year.
