

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD  
RESOLUTION NO. 76-23

DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO  
TRANSMIT COPIES OF BOARD ORDER  
CONCERNING THE SANTA MARGARITA PROJECT  
TO APPROPRIATE FEDERAL OFFICIALS

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board on March 18, 1976 adopted its order granting to the U. S. Bureau of Reclamation an extension of time in which to complete construction and use of water under Permits 8511, 11356, 11357 and 15000 (Applications 11587, 12178, 12179 and 21471) for the Bureau's Santa Margarita Project.
2. A term of said order requires that permittee include a copy thereof, as well as a copy of any further order adopted by the State Board in this matter, as a part of the documentation submitted to the Congress in connection with permittee's request for project authorization.
3. Notice of this requirement should be given to those officers and legislators of the federal government concerned with this project and its authorization.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board does direct and authorize the Executive Officer to transmit a copy of this resolution and the Board's order to the Commissioner of Reclamation, the Secretary of the Interior, and Chairmen of the following United States congressional committees and subcommittees: Senate--Interior and Insular Affairs Committee and its Energy Research and Water Resources Subcommittee, Public Works Committee and its Water Resources Subcommittee; House of Representatives--Interior and Insular Affairs Committee and its Water and Power Resources Subcommittee, Public Works and Transportation Committee and its Water Resources Subcommittee.
