RESOLUTION 76-108

REVIEW OF ACTION OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL
WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, NORTH COAST REGION,
REGARDING ADOPTION OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS
FOR CROWN SIMPSON PULP COMPANY (ORDER NO. 76-133)
AND LOUISIANA-PACIFIC CORPORATION (ORDER NO. 76-134)

WHEREAS:

1. On August 26, 1976, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, North Coast Region (Regional Board) adopted Waste Discharge Requirements for Crown Simpson Pulp Company (Order No. 76-133 NPDES CA0005282) and Louisiana-Pacific Corporation (Order No. 76-134 NPDES CA0005894), wherein the Regional Board granted variances from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Effluent Limitations Guidelines based on a finding of "fundamental difference" and granted exemptions to the effluent limitations included in Table A of the Ocean Plan.
2. On September 3, 1976, EPA objected in writing to the subject permits.
3. After consideration of the circumstances surrounding the adoption of the aforementioned Regional Board Orders, it appears to the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) that the actions of the Regional Board in this matter should be reviewed by the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board will review, on its own motion, the actions of the Regional Board in adopting its Orders Nos. 76-133 and 76-134.
