

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 77-2

APPROVING ORDER NO. 76-230 AND ORDER NO. 76-231 OF THE
CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD
AMENDING THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, SACRAMENTO
RIVER BASIN (5A)

WHEREAS:

1. At its October 22, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin (5A), which prohibit discharge of waste from new leaching and percolation systems within the Anderson-Cottonwood Irrigation District, Community of Cottonwood, Shasta County, and within the Daphne-dale area, Modoc County, and which prohibit any discharge of waste from existing leaching or percolation systems in such areas after January 1, 1981.
2. These prohibitions are reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding sewage overflows within the designated areas and the threat of contamination of water supply wells surface waters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve Order No. 76-230 and Order No. 76-231 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin.
