RESOLUTION NO. 77-86

AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY FOR 208 PLANNING IN NONDESIGNATED AREAS

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board, in conjunction with the appropriate Regional Boards, is responsible for the preparation of water quality control plans for nondesignated areas of the State (North Coast, Lahontan, Colorado River Basin, and portions of the Central Valley and Central Coast Regions) pursuant to Section 208 of Public Law 92-500.
2. The State Board of Forestry is responsible for the adoption and enforcement of forest practice rules.
3. It is appropriate that the State Board of Forestry be delegated the responsibility of identifying best management practices for silviculture on state and private lands as a part of the nondesignated area 208 planning program.
4. The Redwood Creek watershed has been identified by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency as an area of critical water quality concern.
5. A Memorandum of Understanding will provide a formal basis for delineation of planning responsibilities between the State Board and the State Board of Forestry.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Chairman of the State Water Resources Control Board be authorized to execute, on behalf of the Board, a Memorandum of Understanding between the State Water Resources Control Board and the State Board of Forestry, and that the Executive Director, Water Quality, be authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement in an amount not to exceed \$200,000, with the State Board of Forestry to perform tasks consistent with the Memorandum of Understanding, including the development of a workplan for water quality control in the Redwood Creek watershed, as a part of the 208 planning program for the nondesignated area of the State.
