

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 78-19

APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 78-1 AND RESOLUTION NO. 78-2
OF THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL
BOARD AMENDING THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE
SAN FRANCISCO BAY BASIN (2)

WHEREAS:

1. At its January 17, 1978 meeting, the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin which revise wastewater discharge prohibitions in the Stinson Beach and Suisun Beach areas.
2. Resolution 78-1 revises an existing individual disposal system prohibition in the Stinson Beach area of Marin County to allow for continued use of such systems where regulated by the Stinson Beach County Water District.
3. The Regional Board has placed stringent monitoring, inspection, and reporting requirements on the maintenance district to minimize the occurrence of possible septic tank failures.
4. Resolution 78-2 amends a prohibition of direct discharge of wastewater during dry weather to Suisun Marsh to allow the discharge of good quality agricultural return flows.
5. The Regional Board prepared a negative declaration, in accordance with CEQA, on the revision of the discharge prohibition to Suisun Marsh and determined that there will be no substantial adverse environmental impacts resulting from the discharge of agricultural return flows to Suisun Marsh.
6. These prohibition revisions are reasonable and warranted in light of the evidence resulting from Regional Board investigations.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve Resolution No. 78-1 and Resolution No. 78-2 of the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, San Francisco Bay Basin.
