RESOLUTION NO. 78-37

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A
COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE U. S. DEPARTMENT
OF THE INTERIOR, GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, FOR THE
DEVELOPMENT OF AN INVENTORY OF GROUNDWATER
QUALITY MONITORING NETWORKS IN CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:


1. Under the provisions of the Porter-Cologne Act, the State Board is responsible for coordinating and controlling water quality activities within the State, including water quality investigations.
2. The State Board is concerned about the adequacy of monitoring networks in major groundwater basins throughout the State.
3. The State Board is called upon by various state, federal, and local agencies to provide information regarding groundwater monitoring networks in the State.
4. The efficient execution of these State Board activities is dependent on a mechanism by which groundwater monitoring activities can be quickly and accurately referenced.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a cooperative agreement with the U. S. Department of the Interior, Geological Survey, to develop an inventory of active groundwater quality monitoring networks in Priority I groundwater basins for an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the period ending January 31, 1980.
