STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 79-26

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE A CONSULTANT CONTRACT FOR SERVICES RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CLAIMS

WHEREAS:

- 1. There are numerous construction contractor claims on Clean Water Grant funded projects.
- 2. The grantees must negotiate and settle the claims and the Division must evaluate the settlements for grant funding.
- 3. Development of guidance to grantees and Division staff on claims prevention, management and fundability should provide substantial savings to the Clean Water Grant Program.
- 4. There are insufficient resources and expertise within the Division to develop subject guidance.
- 5. The University of California, Berkeley Campus, has in-depth expertise and resources on contract claims and has submitted a proposal to develop subject guidance.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to execute a contract with the University of California on behalf of the Board for consultant services related to the Clean Water Grant Program to be performed in Fiscal Year 1978-79 in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.
