RESOLUTION 79-110

WHEREAS:

1. The Board continues to believe its relations with elected officials of local governments, and with their regional agencies, are important in achieving cooperative progress toward improving California's water quality;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board supports the desire of local governments and their regional agencies to strengthen the partnership with the State in environmental management;
2. That the Board encourages and supports the above participation of local governments and their regional agencies in preparation of the State/EPA Agreement for Fiscal Year 1981 to ensure that local and regional priorities are incorporated;
3. That the Board supports the concept of a Memorandum of Understanding with local or regional agencies covering appropriate portions of the 1980-81 State/EPA Agreement; and
4. That the Board intends to work closely with local governments and their regional agencies in order to accomplish these resolves.
