RESOLUTION NO. 81-21

APPROVAL OF REVISIONS TO THE ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY
AREA GOVERNMENTS WORKPLAN FOR PHASE IV 208 PLANNING

WHEREAS:


1. The State Board, on January 22, 1981, approved the workplans for the Phase IV (F.Y. 1980-81) 208 planning proposals.
2. The State Board staff was directed to further evaluate the Strawberry Fertilizer Management and Agricultural Erosion Control elements of the AMBAG Phase IV workplan and resubmit any substantial changes to this workplan for approval.
3. The State Board staff has completed its evaluation and found that funding for all of the Strawberry Fertilizer Management and a portion of the Agricultural Erosion Control elements would result in duplication of work done elsewhere.
4. The State Board staff has determined that the funding that was to be spent on the two elements indicated above is needed to augment three other elements of the AMBAG Phase IV workplan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That grant funding for AMBAG Phase IV Workplan Element V, Strawberry Fertilizer Management is denied.
2. That grant funding for AMBAG Phase IV Workplan Element VII, Agricultural Erosion Control is reduced to \$13,370 of 208 funds.
3. That the 208 monies made available by the revisions to the Strawberry Fertilizer Management and Agricultural Erosion Control Elements be added to the AMBAG elements entitled Overall Groundwater Management, River Habitat Management, and Public Participation to increase their total 208 funding to \$33,880; \$52,875; and \$21,750, respectively.
