STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 83-53

APPROVAL OF THE FINAL REPORT GROUNDWATER CONTAMINATION BY PESTICIDES: A CALIFORNIA ASSESSMENT

WHEREAS:

- 1. The State Water Resources Control Board is responsible for conducting Section 208 planning in accordance with the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 and subsequent amendments, and
- 2. The State Board Toxic Substances Control Program's Phase II 208 Pesticide Program examined statewide impacts of pesticide use, and
- 3. The State Board Toxic Substances Control Program's Phase II 208 Workplan includes an element for determining the mechanisms of ground water contamination by pesticides, and
- 4. The State Board entered into a contract with Ramlit Associates for the purpose of developing an assessment of ground water contamination by pesticides, and
- 5. Ramlit Associates submitted a Final Report <u>Groundwater Contamination by Pesticides: A California Assessment</u> in May 1983, and
- 6. The State Board has reviewed the Final Report and finds that it fulfills the contract objectives.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

- 1. Approves the Final Report Groundwater Contamination by Pesticides:

 A California Assessment, submitted by Ramlit Associates as completion of their contract with the State Board;
- 2. Approves the report's recommendations, and
- 3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit a copy of the Final Report to EPA for its review and approval.
