RESOLUTION NO. 84-77

COMPLETION OF THE ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY
AREA GOVERNMENTS' PHASE IV 208 "PAJARO BASIN
GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT STUDY"

WHEREAS:

1. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) was awarded a Phase IV 208 grant to conduct studies in the Pajaro Valley.
2. One of these studies called for development of a ground water management plan which would prevent further sea water intrusion, control ground water levels, and protect natural recharge areas.
3. AMBAG's consultant prepared a plan titled "Pajaro Basin Groundwater Management Study" with assistance from a Technical Advisory Committee composed of local agency representatives and interested citizens.
4. AMBAG accepted this plan at their September 13, 1984 Board meeting by adopting Resolution No. 1984-34 which amended the Water Quality Management Plan for the Monterey Bay Region to include the study recommendations.
5. The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Coast Region, reviewed the plan and found that the plan recommendations are consistent with the Central Coastal Water Quality Control Plan.
6. The State Board considered this study at the November 1984 Workshop and Board meeting.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Approves the "Pajaro Basin Groundwater Management Study" as completing AMBAG's Phase IV 208 workplan requirements for this project.
2. Certifies the report recommendations as Best Management Practices and as an amendment to the Water Quality Management Plan for the Monterey Bay Region.

3. Directs the Executive Director to transmit the report to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency requesting their review and approval.
