

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 87 - 102

APPROVAL OF THE GROUND WATER QUALITY
PROTECTION STRATEGY FOR CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board was designated as the lead agency to develop a ground water quality protection strategy for California.
2. California has recently undergone a series of federal and state statutory revisions that directly or indirectly deals with ground water.
3. The legislatively directed programs have developed independently due to time schedules.
4. The State Board held two hearings to receive public comments on a draft ground water quality protection strategy.
5. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency developed a national strategy which relies on individual state strategies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board adopts the attached Ground Water Quality Protection Strategy for California.
