ADOPTION OF PROJECT PRIORITY LIST FOR POLLUTION STUDIES

WHEREAS:


1. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 established the Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program to help small communities with funding for wastewater treatment works;
2. The Supplemental State Grant Assistance Program provides grant assistance in amounts up to 97-1/2 percent to fund pollution studies;
3. Regional Boards and local health officials have nominated 77 projects for consideration for pollution study grants. State Board staff has ranked these projects into two priority classes; and
4. The Division of Loans and Grants proposes that the State Board provide grant assistance for 53 "eligible/fundable" Class 1 pollution study projects, and set aside \$1.8 million from the Small Communities Assistance Account to fund these pollution studies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Adopts the attached priority list for pollution study grants; and
2. Sets aside \$1.8 million, for a period not to exceed two years, to fund these pollution studies.
