RESOLUTION NO. 88-86

ADOPTION OF THE LANGUAGE FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE
PROCEDURES MANUAL REGARDING ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS FOR FAILURE TO
COMPLY WITH THE PROHIBITIONS IN THE TOXIC PITS CLEANUP ACT

WHEREAS:

1. The Toxic Pits Cleanup Act (TPCA) includes deadlines for cessation of discharge of liquid hazardous wastes and hazardous wastes containing free liquids to surface impoundments; and
2. The Resources Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) includes deadlines for closure of certain hazardous waste disposal facilities; and
3. It is necessary to provide direction to the Regional Water Quality Control Boards involved in enforcement of the provisions of the TPCA and RCRA Programs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Water Resources Control Board, after due consideration, does hereby adopt the attached language for the Administrative Procedures Manual regarding "Enforcement Actions For Failure To Comply With The Prohibitions In The Toxic Pits Cleanup Act".
