RESOLUTION No. 89-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A WATER LABORATORY SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO SUPPORT ONGOING REGULATORY AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION (SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGIONAL BOARD)

WHEREAS:


1. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board has a continuing need for laboratory analyses of water quality samples taken as part of its regulatory programs.
2. The current laboratory services contract with NET Pacific, Inc. does not include laboratory services related to Underground Storage Tanks or AB 1803, Compliance Inspections. An additional \$23,000 has been budgeted to cover these needed services.
3. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board wants to increase the current contract with NET Pacific, Inc. from \$87,304 to \$110,304 for water laboratory services related to Underground Storage Tanks and AB 1803, Compliance Inspections.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a water laboratory services contract amendment to support the water quality monitoring activities of the San Francisco Bay Regional Board for an amount not to exceed \$23,000 (contract total \$110,304) for Fiscal Year 1988-89, subject to availability of funds.
