RESOLUTION NO. 89- 22

APPROVAL OF REDIRECTION OF FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT
TITLE II FUNDS FOR PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF
NONPOINT SOURCE ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is proposing to implement two new nonpoint source (NPS) activities and continue two ongoing NPS activities beginning in fiscal year (FY) 1989-90.
2. There is a recognized need to initiate or continue the following NPS activities using federal funds:
 - a. Four-Year Forest Practices \$2,950,000
Water Quality Management Program
 - b. Three-Year Bays and Estuaries 640,000
Policy Revision
 - c. Basin Planning for Nonpoint Sources 3,380,000
 - d. Nonpoint Source Program 1,000,000

\$7,970,000
3. Section 201(g) of the federal Clean Water Act allows for the Governor (authority delegated to the Chairman of the State Board in California) to redirect up to 20 percent of the Clean Water Act Title II allocation to specific activities, including nonpoint source planning, management, and control.
4. The State Board reserved \$2,000,000 of the federal fiscal year (FFY) 1989 Title II allocation for NPS activities in the process of adopting the FFY 1989 Intended Use Plan for the Title VI State Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund.
5. The State Board will need to reserve \$5,970,000 for NPS activities in the FFY 1990 Intended Use Plan.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Approves redirection of a total of \$7,970,000 from the Clean Water Act FFY 1989 and FFY 1990 Title II allocations to support NPS activities.
2. Authorizes the Executive Director, or his designee, to apply for and accept grants from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to support nonpoint source activities in accordance with the maximum funding authorized by Resolve No. 1.

3. Authorizes the Executive Director, after advising the State Board, to submit workplans supporting the grant requests to EPA.
4. Authorizes the Executive Director, or his designee, to negotiate, execute, and/or amend contracts and agreements in accordance with the workplans to implement the NPS activities.
