ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 1989-90 ANNUAL FEE
FOR FACILITIES SUBJECT TO THE TOXIC PITS CLEANUP ACT (TPCA)

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) is required, pursuant to Section 2201(c) (2) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations, to set fees payable by any person discharging any liquid hazardous waste or hazardous waste containing free liquids into a surface impoundment.
2. The State Board has considered budgetary requirements of the Toxic Pits Cleanup Act program for FY 1989-90 and anticipated revenues from the FY 1989-90 fees.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board hereby sets annual fees payable on July 1, 1989 by persons discharging liquid hazardous waste or hazardous waste containing free liquids to surface impoundments at \$3,000 for each facility, plus \$300 for each additional surface impoundment at the facility, pursuant to Section 2201(c) (2) of Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations.
