RESOLUTION NO. 89-35

ADOPTION OF MULTIAGENCY SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS
REGARDING THE IMPACT OF TOXIC AIR QUALITY REGULATIONS
ON CALIFORNIA PUBLICLY OWNED TREATMENT WORKS (POTWs)

WHEREAS:


1. The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) proposes to adopt two rules to control emissions from POTWs that will impact their operation and construction;
2. Other regulatory agencies are proposing air pollution regulations that will impact operation and construction of POTWs;
3. A subcommittee, commissioned by a multiagency committee representing local, state, and federal regulatory agencies, POTWs, and interested parties was formed to assess the impact of air pollution regulations on POTWs, and has prepared a report on the magnitude of toxic air emissions of POTWs, cross-media impacts and recommendations for control strategies; and
4. The subcommittee is implementing the recommendations of it's report by establishing technical workgroups, and will establish a multiagency review process to evaluate cross media impacts of environmental regulations.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Adopt the multiagency subcommittee recommendations as set forth in the report "The Impacts of Toxic Air Quality Regulations on California Publicly Owned Treatment Works" dated October 1988.
