ACCEPTANCE OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY, PLANNING
AND STANDARDS DEVELOPMENT BRANCH, PHASE I 205(j)(2)
FINAL REPORT ENTITLED SACRAMENTO RIVER TOXIC
CHEMICAL RISK ASSESSMENT PROJECT: FINAL REPORT,
AS COMPLETION OF THE "SACRAMENTO RIVER TOXIC
CHEMICAL RISK ASSESSMENT PROJECT"

WHEREAS:

1. Pursuant to the terms of a Phase I 205(j)(2) grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the State Water Resources Control Board (State Board) provided \$126,000 in Phase I 205(j)(2) funds to the State Board's Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Development Branch, to conduct the Phase I 205(j)(2) "Sacramento River Toxic Chemical Risk Assessment Project" (Project).
2. The Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Development Branch, has submitted to the State Board the final report entitled Sacramento River Toxic Chemical Risk Assessment Project: Final Report (Final Report).
3. The State Board has found that the aforementioned Final Report conforms to the requirements of the EPA Phase I 205(j)(2) Project workplan.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board:

1. Finds that the Division of Water Quality, Planning and Standards Development Branch, Phase I 205(j)(2) Project workplan has been satisfactorily completed.
2. Directs staff to transmit the Final Report to EPA as completion of the Project.
3. Directs staff to make known the availability of the Final Report to the appropriate Regional Boards, local agencies, and other interested parties.
4. Accepts this as a technical staff report.
