ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF INSPECTION FOR ABOVEGROUND TANK FACILITIES

WHEREAS:


1. Section 25270.5(a) of Division 20 of the Health and Safety Code requires the State Board to adopt a schedule for the inspection of aboveground tank facilities.
2. In adopting the subject schedule, the State Board has given special attention to those facilities which are near navigable waters, potable water supplies, or sensitive ecosystems.
3. Regional Boards will conduct periodic inspections of each aboveground storage tank at a facility in accordance with a schedule adopted by the State Board.
4. Regional Boards have identified those facilities which can be inspected during the current State Fiscal Year (1990-1991) within budgeted resources, and those facilities are listed in Attachment 1 to this resolution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board adopt the inspection schedule for aboveground tank facilities identified in Attachment 1.
