RESOLUTION NO. 91-72

APPROVAL OF A REQUEST FOR A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR
THE CITY OF STOCKTON

WHEREAS:


1. The City of Stockton (City) has requested a \$1.9 million loan from the State Revolving Fund (SRF) to implement its Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Urban Runoff (Program);
2. Implementation of the Program will advance the City toward compliance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the control of pollutants in stormwater discharges; and
3. The City's Program is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15262 of the State CEQA guidelines.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Intended Use Plan for the SRF is amended to include the City's Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Urban Runoff.
2. That the Nonpoint Source Management Plan is amended to include the City's Program to Reduce Pollutant Loading from Urban Runoff.
3. That an SRF loan of \$1.9 million is approved for the City of Stockton, with a repayment period of ten years, and that the first payment is to be due one (1) year after completion of the City's three-(3) year Program.
4. That the SRF Priority List is amended to include the City's Program as a fundable project.
