APPROVAL OF AN INCREASED STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN
FOR THE BEAR VALLEY COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
PROJECT NO. C-06-4136-110

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB), on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended on September 20, 1990 and January 21, 1993;
2. The SWRCB, on July 22, 1993, adopted Resolution 93-65 approving a \$1.4 million SRF loan for the Bear Valley Community Services District.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board approves a State Revolving Fund loan increase from \$1.4 million to \$2.5 million for the Bear Valley Community Services District for the construction of wastewater treatment facilities for the community of Bear Valley Springs, Project No. C-06-4136-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first payment to be due one (1) year after the completion of construction.

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990 and January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992 adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Bear Valley Community Services District project as scheduled for FFY 1993;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, water conservation plan, and draft revenue program for this project; and
4. The Bear Valley Community Services District Board of Directors adopted a Negative Declaration for the proposed project (State Clearinghouse No. 92092023) which has been reviewed and considered by the State Water Board, and it has been determined that the proposed project will not result in significant negative environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a loan of \$1.4 million for the Bear Valley Community Services District for the construction of wastewater treatment facilities for the community of Bear Valley Springs, Project No. C-06-4136-110, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first payment to be due one (1) year after the completion of construction.
