RESOLUTION NO. R5-2015-0017

APPROVING AN INITIAL STUDY
AND
ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR
GENERAL ORDER FOR INSITU GROUNDWATER REMEDIATION AND
DISCHARGE OF TREATED GROUNDWATER TO LAND

WHEREAS, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region (Regional Board) proposes to adopted a General Order for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation and Discharge of Treated Groundwater to Land; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Board is the lead agency for this project under the California Environmental Quality Act and has conducted an Initial Study in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Section 15063, entitled *Guidelines for the Implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act*, and

WHEREAS, conditions included in the proposed General Order and identified in the Negative Declaration will avoid the project's potential significant effects or will reduce such effects to a less than significant impact; and

WHEREAS, copies of the Initial Study and proposed Negative Declaration were transmitted to or made available to all agencies and persons known to be interested in these matters and the public notice provided exceeded the legal requirements for such notice; and

WHEREAS, the comments received have been addressed; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Board considered all testimony and evidence at a public hearing held on 6 February 2015 in Sacramento, California, and good cause was found to approve the Initial Study and adopt a Negative Declaration.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Central Valley Region finds:

1. The Initial Study is approved and the Negative Declaration for the *General Order for In-Situ Groundwater Remediation and Discharge of Treated Groundwater to Land* is adopted.
