MONITORING

ANNUAL STATUS REPORT

1. Estimate of the total maximum daily flow of wastewater discharged to the basins.
2. List any proposed changes in the disposal facilities during the upcoming year.
3. Report the quantity, method and location of disposal of any sludge removed from the basins.

SEMI-ANNUAL MONITORING

1. The wastewater discharged to the basins shall be monitored for the following:

<u>Constituent</u>	<u>Unit</u>	<u>Type of Sample</u>	<u>Sampling Frequency</u>
Total Dissolved Solids	mg/L ¹	Grab	Semi-Annually
Suspended Solids	mg/L	Grab	Semi-Annually
20 ⁰ BOD ₅	mg/L	6-Hour Composite	Semi-Annually
Hydrogen Ion	pH	Grab	Semi-Annually

The collection, preservation and holding times of all samples shall be in accordance with U. S. Environmental Protection Agency approved procedures. All analyses shall be conducted by a laboratory certified by the State Department of Health Services to perform the required analyses.

REPORTING

¹ mg/L - milligrams-per-Liter

1. The discharger shall arrange the data in tabular form so that the specified information is readily discernible. The data shall be summarized in such a manner as to clearly illustrate whether the facility is operating in compliance with the waste discharge requirements.
2. Report immediately any failure in the wastewater treatment and disposal system to the Regional Board's Executive Officer and Director of County Environmental Health by telephone with follow-up by letter.
3. Monitoring reports shall be certified under penalty of perjury to be true and correct, and shall contain the required information at the frequency designated in this program.
4. Each report shall contain the following statement:

"I declare under the penalty of law that I have personally examined and am familiar with the information submitted in this document, and based on my inquiry of those individuals immediately responsible for obtaining the information, I believe that the information is true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of a fine and imprisonment for knowing violations."

5. Monitoring reports due semi-annually shall be submitted to the Regional Board by January 15, and July 15 each year. Annual monitoring reports shall be submitted to the Board by January 15 each year.
