Subject: October 11 Weekly Update on Curtailment Status of Water Rights and Claims in the Delta Watershed

This email contains important information about the curtailment status of water rights and claims of right within the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta (Delta) watershed pursuant to Initial Orders Imposing Water Right Curtailment and Reporting Requirements in the Delta Watershed (Order for water rights/claims under 5,000 acre-feet and Order for water rights/claims over 5,000 acre-feet).

The following water rights are curtailed, effective October 12, 2022, unless and until the State Water Board advises that this determination has been updated:

- 1. Water rights and claims on the following <u>Sacramento River</u> tributaries:
 - Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Cache Creek</u> subwatershed with a priority date of 1859 or later; and
 - b. Post-1914 appropriative water rights in the <u>Putah Creek</u> subwatershed outside of the Legal Delta with a priority date of 1948 or later.
- 2. Post-1914 appropriative water rights in the <u>Sacramento River</u> watershed outside of the Legal Delta with a priority date of 1960 or later.
- 3. Water rights and claims on the following San Joaquin River tributaries:
 - All post-1914 appropriative water rights, pre-1914 appropriative water right claims, and riparian water right claims in the <u>Calaveras River</u> subwatershed outside of the Legal Delta;
 - All post-1914 appropriative water rights, pre-1914 appropriative water right claims, and riparian water right claims in the <u>Chowchilla River</u> subwatershed;
 - c. Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Fresno River</u> subwatershed with a priority date of 1855 or later;
 - d. Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Merced River</u> subwatershed with a priority date of 1859 or later;
 - e. Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Mokelumne River</u> subwatershed outside of the Legal Delta with a priority date of 1890 or later;
 - f. Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Stanislaus River</u> subwatershed outside of the Legal Delta with a priority date of 1897 or later; and
 - g. Post-1914 appropriative water rights and pre-1914 appropriative water right claims in the <u>Tuolumne River</u> subwatershed with a priority date of 1914 or later.
- 4. Post-1914 appropriative water rights in the <u>San Joaquin River</u> watershed outside of the Legal Delta with a priority date of 1919 or later.

5. Post-1914 appropriative water rights in the <u>Legal Delta</u> with a priority date of 1960 or later.

Term 91 curtailments will continue to apply to rights within and outside the Legal Delta containing Term 91.

Today's update considers observed water supply data and forecasts from the California Nevada River Forecast Center (CNRFC) that were updated on October 10, 2022. The 50 percent exceedance water supply forecast was selected to determine curtailments at this time. Demand data informing curtailments are based on reported diversions from 2018 as adjusted through an ongoing QA/QC process.

The determination of water unavailability used to inform curtailments is based on the <u>Water Unavailability Methodology for the Delta Watershed</u>. The data used to support curtailments and other relevant information is available on the State Water Board's <u>FTP</u> <u>site</u>. The State Water Board will continue to closely monitor forecasted precipitation and hydrologic conditions in order to issue updates to the curtailment status of water rights and claims in the Delta watershed. The next curtailment status update will be provided by email and web posting no later than October 18, 2022. Please check the <u>Delta</u> <u>Watershed Curtailment Status List</u> for the current curtailment status of each water right and claim in the Delta watershed.

Water right holders and claimants are responsible for monitoring their curtailment status online on the <u>Delta Watershed Curtailment Status List</u>. Notice of changes to curtailment status will not be mailed.
