NOTICE OF LODGING OF AMENDED AND RESTATED CONSENT JUDGMENT

WRITTEN COMMENTS DUE BY

Notice is given that on November 6, 2014, an Amended and Restated Consent Judgment and Final Order (Amended Consent Judgment) in The People of the State of California, ex rel., Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region v. The Boeing Company, Case No. 56-2010-00371686-CU-MC-SIM, was lodged with the Superior Court of the State of California, County of Ventura.

In 2010, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (Regional Board) sought judicial civil penalties from The Boeing Company (Boeing) for its failure to comply with the terms of its National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0001309 at its Santa Susana Field Laboratory (SSFL). The Regional Board and Boeing agreed to settle the matter pursuant to the terms of a Consent Judgment, which required Boeing to pay a civil penalty and fund a Supplemental Environmental Project. In the Consent Judgment, Boeing also agreed to the imposition of stipulated penalties for future violations of Boeing's NPDES permit from the period of January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2014. This Amended Consent Judgment extends the period for the imposition of stipulated penalties for future violations of Boeing's NPDES permit through December 31, 2016 and extends the expiration date of the Amended Consent Judgment to June 30, 2017.
