On December 21, 2015, I issued the City of Long Beach (City) a Tentative Approval of its request for low impact development ordinance equivalency under Part VII.J.5.i of Order No. R4-2014-0024. In accordance with Order No. R4-2014-0024, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board (Los Angeles Water Board) provided 30 days for public comment on this tentative approval.

This letter is to notify the City that no comments were received by the Los Angeles Water Board during this 30-day public comment period. The City's request for equivalency is hereby approved.

In the event that data is provided that demonstrates the City's LID Ordinance is not providing equivalent water quality benefits as implementing the default Planning and Development Program, the Los Angeles Water Board Executive Officer reserves the right and ability to rescind the approval.
