What: The Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Central Valley Water Board) will be conducting a one-day workshop at 9 a.m. March 12 on the effects of climate change on water quality in the Central Valley region, and will be discussing potential policy and regulatory responses.

The workshop will consist of several moderated discussions to assess:

- 1) Impacts of climate change in the Central Valley.
- 2) Policy responses of other government entities.
- 3) The needs and concerns of stakeholders in the Valley.

The workshop will be the first step in the development of a Climate Change Work Plan for the Central Valley Water Board.
