to Be Released June 2 by the State Water Board

What: The monthly reporting system that shows estimated daily water use per person as well as total water use for nearly every community water system statewide continues.
The statewide enforcement data for April will also be discussed before the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) during an informational Board discussion item June 2. The item is number 6 on this <u>agenda</u>.

This reporting system includes total water use and residential per-capita per day (R-GPCD). The reporting of monthly water use was called for in an emergency water conservation regulations adopted by the board in <u>July</u> 2014 and renewed in <u>March</u> of this year.

Beginning this month, urban water suppliers will be reporting all enforcement activities. The first full month of enforcement data will be posted <u>here</u>, when the Board hears the presentation June 2.
