NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

PROPOSED APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR THE LAHONTAN REGION TO REMOVE THE MUNICIPAL AND DOMESTIC SUPPLY (MUN) BENEFICIAL USE DESIGNATION FROM CERTAIN GROUND WATERS BENEATH NAVAL AIR WEAPONS STATION (NAWS) CHINA LAKE, KERN, INYO, AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept comments on the proposed approval of the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board's (Lahontan Water Board's) amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan for the Lahontan Basin that would remove the MUN beneficial use designation from certain ground waters beneath NAWS China Lake (Basin Plan amendment). The Basin Plan amendment was adopted by the Lahontan Water Board on February 11, 2015 (Resolution No. R6V-2015-0005), and is available for review at:

Oral comments at the State Water Board meeting generally will be limited to a summary of the written comments submitted during the written comment period. REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING COMMENTS (23 Cal. Code Regs., § 3779, subd. (f)). The State Water Board may refuse to accept any comments that do not satisfy all of the following requirements:

- 1. Comments must specifically address the final version of the Basin Plan amendment adopted by the Lahontan Water Board.
- If the Lahontan Water Board previously responded to a similar or identical comment, the commenter must explain why and in what manner the commenter believes each of the responses provided by the Lahontan Water Board to each comment was inadequate or incorrect.
- 3. The commenter also must include either a statement that each of the comments was timely raised before the Lahontan Water Board, or an explanation of why the commenter was unable to raise the specific comment before the Lahontan Water Board.
