**SUBJECT: ADDENDUM NUMBER 4 TO CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ORDER
NO. 93-49**

Directive 9 of Cleanup and Abatement Order (CAO) No. 93-49 requires the dischargers to submit quarterly progress reports on the implementation of the Corrective Action Plan (CAP) for cleanup of the Julian groundwater petroleum hydrocarbon plume. The cleanup alternative selected for implementation in the December 2000 CAP was source reduction by soil vapor extraction (SVE). Construction of the SVE system began in 2001 with system start up in 2002. Specifically, the SVE system connected to extraction wells at the former Chevron, the former Julian Auto Parts, and the Julian Cider Mill was completed and started on June 6, 2002. The SVE system at Norm's Service Station started operation in July 2002.

The current remediation system has been in operation for a little over a year. Although the CAO requires quarterly progress reports on CAP implementation, a semi-annual reporting period is sufficient to summarize remediation progress. Additionally, producing two reports per year instead of four will be less costly to the dischargers.

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Therefore, Addendum No. 4 to CAO No. 93-49 amends Directive 9 as follows:

Directive 9. The dischargers shall submit semi-annual progress reports on the implementation of the Corrective Action Plan in accordance with the following reporting schedule:


<u>Reporting Period</u>	<u>Report Due</u>
January 1 – June 30	July 30
July 1 – December 31	January 30

Parts a through e of Directive 9, which specify the information to be included in the progress reports, are unchanged.
