#### GENERAL NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT FOR THE DISCHARGE OF LANTHANUM-MODIFIED CLAY TO SURFACE WATERS OF THE UNITED STATES IN THE SAN DIEGO REGION

The following changes have been made to Tentative Order No. R9-2012-0063 in response to comments. Changes below are show in underline/strikeout format to indicate added or removed language, respectively.

Page 5, Section F. Notifications

1. This General Permit serves as a general NPDES Permit for the discharge of lanthanum-modified clay to surface waters to bind phosphorus to improve water quality ~~by limiting nutrient availability to algae and aquatic weeds.~~

Page 10, Section VI.A.1. i) Receiving Water Limitations – Surface Water Limitations –

... The transparency of waters in lagoons and estuaries shall not be less than 50% of the depth at locations where measurement is made by means of a standard secchi disk, except where lesser transparency is caused by rainfall runoff from undisturbed natural areas and dredging projects conducted in conformance with waste discharge requirements of the Regional Board. ~~With these two exceptions,~~ For lagoons and estuaries, increases in turbidity attributable to controllable water quality factors shall not exceed the following limits: ...
