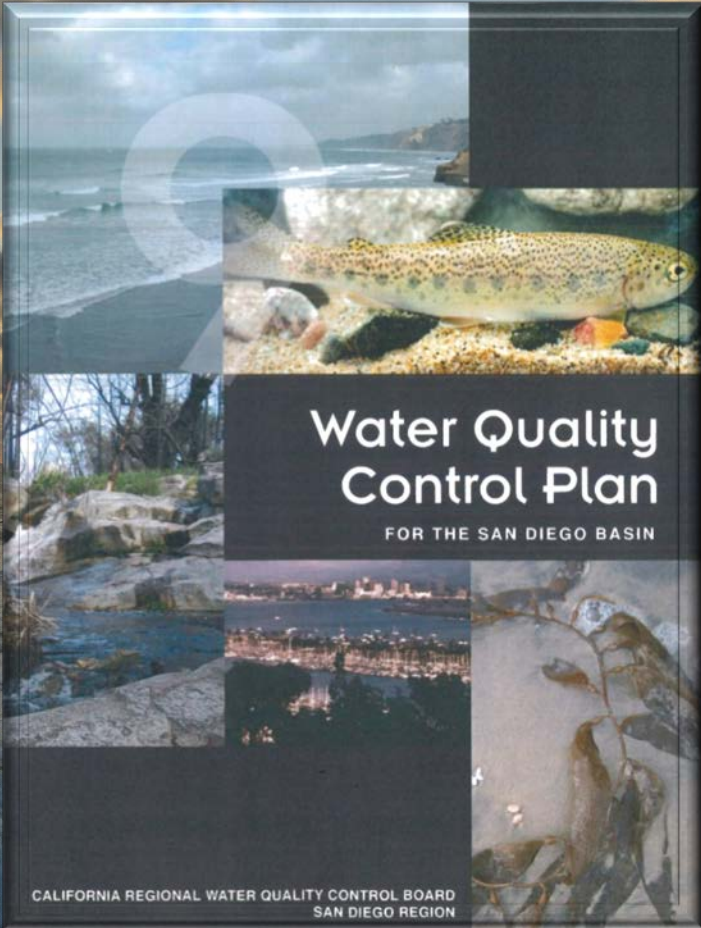

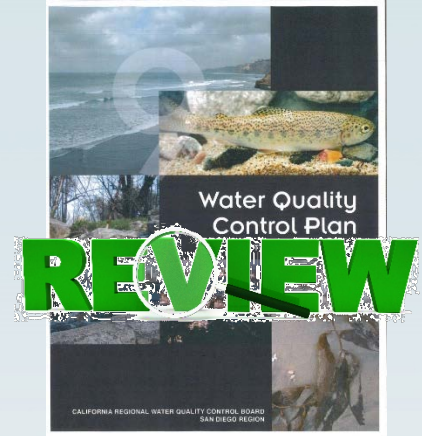

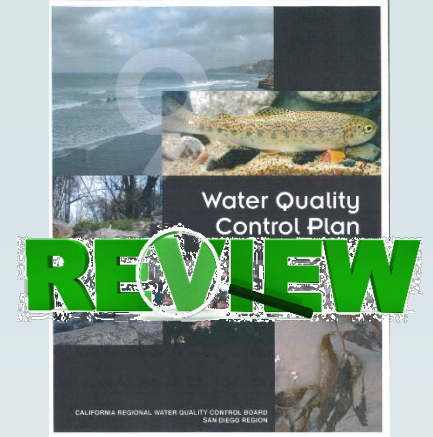
Triennial Review

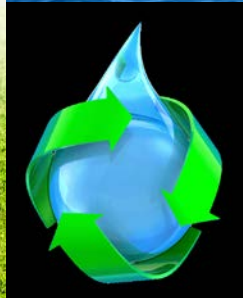

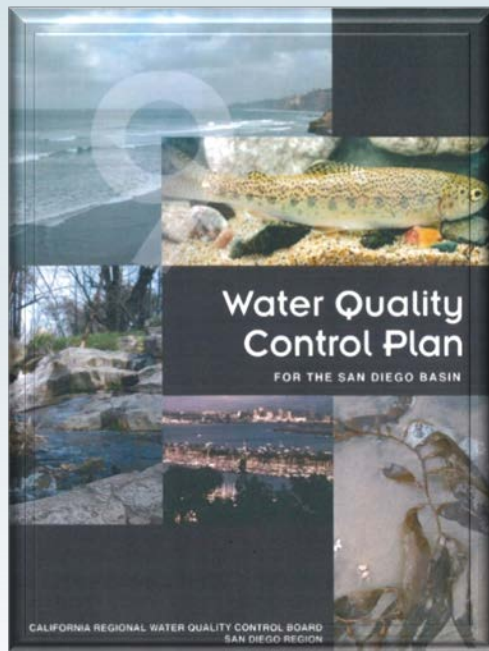
