SUBJECT

NPDES Permit Amendment: Non-substantive Typographical Corrections to Order No. Order No. R9-2019-0167, NPDES No. CA0109347, Waste Discharge Requirements for the Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton Southern Regional Tertiary Treatment Plant and Advanced Water Treatment Plant at Haybarn Canyon Discharge to the Pacific Ocean through the Oceanside Ocean Outfall (Tentative Order No. R9-2020-0191). (*Joann Lim*)

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Adoption of Tentative Order No. R9-2020-0191 (Tentative Order, **Supporting Document No. 1**) amending Order No. R9-2019-0167 is recommended.

KEY ISSUES

1. The Tentative Order makes minor modifications to Order No. R9-2019-0167 to correct non-substantive typographical errors.
2. The corrections to Order No. R9-2019-0167 are being processed with the consent of the Marine Corps Base, Camp Pendleton (MCBCP) as minor permit modifications pursuant to 40 CFR section 122.63.

PRACTICAL VISION

Adoption of the Tentative Order is consistent with the values of transparency and communication outlined in the Proactive Public Outreach and Communication chapter of the Practical Vision¹ as it proposes changes to an existing permit through a transparent public meeting process.

DISCUSSION

The Tentative Order proposes to amend Order No. R9-2019-0167 to correct non-substantive typographical errors including correcting the Ocean Plan table references, correcting table names, changing some text to subscript or superscript, and correcting the page number for the table of contents. The sections in Order No. R9-2019-0167 that will be corrected are identified in page 2 of the Tentative Order and shown in redline/strikeout format in the Attachment to the Tentative Order (see **Supporting Document No. 1**).

Order No. R9-2019-0167 regulates the MCBCP's discharge of secondary-treated wastewater and brine through the Oceanside Ocean Outfall to the Pacific Ocean. A map showing the location of the MCBCP's facilities is included as **Supporting Document No. 2**.

The San Diego Water Board provided an opportunity for the MCBCP to review the proposed modifications to Order No. R9-2019-0167 prior to placing the Tentative Order on the August 12, 2020 Board meeting agenda. MCBCP consented to the proposed changes by email dated April 21, 2020 (see **Supporting Document No. 3**).
