**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD**

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Diego Region (San Diego Water Board), is releasing Tentative Order No. R9-2020-0186, *An Order Rescinding Order No. 95-15, Waste Discharge Requirements for Mr. Angelo Forte, Anza Pines Mobile Park, Near Cahuilla, Riverside County* (Tentative Order), for public review and comment. The San Diego Water Board will consider adoption of the Tentative Order at its regularly scheduled meeting on **November 18, 2020**. The Tentative Order, if adopted, will rescind Order No. 95-15, *Waste Discharge Requirements for Mr. Angelo Forte, Anza Pines Mobile Park, Near Cahuilla, Riverside County*.

**Submission of Written Comments**

Notice is hereby given that the San Diego Water Board will accept written comments regarding the Tentative Order in accordance with this notice and pursuant to Water Code section 13167.5.

The written comment period provides an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the Tentative Order. All written comments regarding the Tentative Order must be received no later than **5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 19, 2020**, to be considered by the San Diego Water Board. Written comments sent by mail must be addressed to California Regional Water Quality Control Board – San Diego Region, 2375 Northside Drive, Suite 100, San Diego, California 92108-2700, and ATTN: Ms. Sherrie Komeylyan. Comments can also be submitted by email to [sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov](mailto:sandiego@waterboards.ca.gov). The subject line of all written comments must include “Comment – Tentative Order No. R9-2020-0186.”

Early submission of written comments on the Tentative Order is encouraged. Written comments received by **5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 19, 2020**, will be provided to San Diego Water Board members for their review in advance of the public hearing to consider adoption of the Tentative Order. The San Diego Water Board will prepare written responses to significant comments that are timely received. Consistent with

State Water Resources Control Board regulations that apply to this proceeding, written comments received after **5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 19, 2020**, will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
