SUBJECT: Land Disposal Program Update

CHRONOLOGY: This is an informational item only

DISCUSSION: Terry Seward will provide an informational update on the function and status of Region 2's Land Disposal Program. The Land Disposal Program enforces the regulations that apply to over 100 disposal sites located within the Region.

The Land Disposal Program's main function is to protect State water quality where planned discharges of waste to land occur, such as at municipal solid waste landfills, industrial landfills, mines, and waste water ponds. The Program enforces the regulations contained in the California Code of Regulations Title 27, which regulates the discharge of waste to land. The enforcement of Title 27 regulations assures that wastes will be properly contained to protect human health and the environment.
