BACKGROUND

On July 27, 1992, James J. Hill III (Applicant) filed water-right Application 30166 on behalf of El Sur Ranch with the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board or Board) Division of Water Rights (Division) for a permit to appropriate water from the Big Sur River in Monterey County. The Applicant amended Application 30166 in November and December 2005, October 2006, June 2011, and March 2023. The current application is for a water-right permit that would authorize direct diversion of water at a rate not to exceed 5.84 cubic feet per second (cfs) and diversion to storage of up to 810 acre-feet, with an annual maximum combined diversion of 1,320 acre-feet, and a maximum 20-year rolling annual average of 1,087 acre-feet. Additional information about this proceeding is in the AHO's May 23, 2022 Notice of Status Conference.

The State Water Board held a public hearing on Application 30166 in June and July 2011. On December 9, 2021, the Board's Executive Director assigned Application 30166 to the State Water Board's Administrative Hearings Office (AHO). The AHO held status conferences in this matter on June 30, August 23, September 8, 2022, and October 4, 2022; and February 1 and March 23, 2023.

STATUS CONFERENCE RULING

During the status conference on March 23, 2023, the hearing officer asked the Applicant's representatives whether the Applicant wants to add fire suppression as a proposed beneficial use of water in Application 30166. This change would require a revision to the petition for change and fifth amendment to Application 30166. The Applicant should file a statement with the AHO by **April 7, 2023, at 12:00 p.m.** confirming whether it intends to add fire suppression as a beneficial use of water sought under Application 30166.

As discussed during the status conference, staff of the consulting firm retained by the Applicant to assist the AHO in developing a new or revised environmental document under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) should only communicate with State Water Board staff about this proceeding (1) in writing (by e-mail or letter), and serve all parties listed on the service list for this proceeding with copies of the communication, or (2) orally during a status conference or conference call conducted by the hearing officer in which all parties have an opportunity to participate. Representatives of the Applicant, or the Applicant's consulting firm, may request a conference call by sending an e-mail to the AHO and serving all parties listed on the service list for this proceeding.

STATUS CONFERENCE

The AHO hearing officer will hold a status conference on **April 27, 2023, at 1:00 p.m.** by Zoom teleconference. No in-person appearances will be allowed. The status conference will be held and electronically recorded by Zoom teleconference. The AHO

will not retain a court reporter for the status conference. Any party may arrange for a court reporter at the party's own expense.

The status conferences will be live streamed through the Administrative Hearings Office YouTube channel, accessible by clicking on the link provided below. After the conclusion of the conference, a recording of the YouTube live-stream of the conference will be available on the Administrative Hearings Office YouTube channel. These recordings will include automatic captions for accessibility.

During the status conference, the hearing officer will discuss the following issues with the Applicant and a representative of the consulting firm retained by the Applicant to assist the AHO in developing a new or revised environmental document. The hearing officer will also invite comments from representatives of the interested parties who participate in the status conference.

- 1. What type of new environmental document or revision to the 2011 uncertified Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) does CEQA require the State Water Board to prepare, as the lead agency, to address changes to the Applicant's proposed project in the fifth amendment to Application 30166?
- 2. Are the following the most appropriate next steps by the Applicant's CEQA consultant to assist the AHO in developing a new environmental document or revision to the 2011 uncertified FEIR?
 - a. Prepare a draft updated initial study to identify potential environmental impacts of the project proposed in Application 30166, as amended on March 3, 2023, that were not addressed in the 2011 uncertified FEIR.
 - b. Prepare a draft supplemental notice of preparation that identifies potential environmental impacts of the project proposed in Application 30166, as amended on March 3, 2023, that were not addressed in the 2011 uncertified FEIR.
- 3. What is a proposed schedule for the consultant to develop a draft updated initial study, draft supplemental notice of preparation, and draft of a new environmental document or revision to the 2011 uncertified FEIR?

The hearing officer may address other issues raised by the parties during the status conference or in a status conference statement. Parties do not need to file status conference statements. If any party wants to file a status conference statement, the party shall file the status conference statement with the AHO and serve copies of it on the other parties listed in the attached service list. The AHO will post the statements on the Water Board AHO-FTP site in the folder for this matter.
