On May 6, 2022, the State Water Resources Control Board ("State Water Board") Administrative Hearings Office ("AHO") issued its Notice of Public Hearing and Pre-Hearing Conference in this proceeding. The purpose of this proceeding, background, hearing issues and related information are discussed in that notice and are not repeated here.

On April 17 and April 19, 2023, two of the attorneys for parties in this proceeding sent me e-mails. These e-mails stated that the parties: (1) would not be submitting files for their calibrated regional and local groundwater models by the April 17, 2023 deadline specified in my March 20, 2023 post-hearing order and notice; and (2) will not be

submitting their model scenario files or written proposed direct testimony and related exhibits by the April 24, 2023 deadline specified in that order. The attorneys have requested that I schedule a status conference to discuss the schedule in this order.

In response to this request, I have scheduled a status conference for the date and time listed on the first page of this notice. This status conference will be held by Zoom teleconference. The purpose of the status conference will be to discuss the status of the parties' preparation of their revised technical models and model scenarios, and potential revisions to the deadlines and schedule specified in my March 20, 2023 post-hearing order and notice.

At least one attorney for each party shall participate in the status conference and be prepared to address these issues and commit to a revised schedule on behalf of the party the attorney represents. The parties shall arrange to have their technical experts available on standby to participate in the status conference in case I want to ask them questions about the status of and schedule for completion of their technical work and documents.
