NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND PROPOSED ADOPTION OF PROPOSED WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR ENCLOSED BAYS AND ESTUARIES OF CALIFORNIA, PART 1, SEDIMENT QUALITY OBJECTIVES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will hold a public hearing to seek comments on the proposed Water Quality Control Plan (Plan) for Enclosed Bays and Estuaries of California, Part 1, Sediment Quality Objectives. The State Water Board may take final action on the Plan at the conclusion of the hearing, or the State Water Board may defer final action to a subsequent, publicly-noticed board meeting.

BACKGROUND


In 2003, the State Water Board initiated a program to develop sediment quality objectives (SQOs) for toxic pollutants in enclosed bays and estuaries. The proposed SQOs use multiple lines of evidence, which integrate chemistry, toxicity, and the condition of the benthic community to determine sediment quality. The State Water Board held a public hearing on the Plan in November 2007, adopted the Plan on February 19, 2008, and submitted it to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) on February 29, 2008. Review by OAL revealed that the statutorily-required newspaper notification of the November 2007 hearing had not occurred. The State Water Board is, therefore, noticing and conducting a new public hearing for the proposed Plan on September 16, 2008.


PARKING AND ACCESSIBILITY
