By signing this stipulation, this named defendant hereby admits the allegations of the complaint. This stipulation is entered into based in part on representations made and reaffirmed by this named defendant herein, that certain penalty

Upon the consent of the parties hereto, and it appearing to the court that there is good cause for the entry of this Stipulated Final Judgment,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

- 1. This court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and each of the parties hereto.
- 2. The injunctive provisions of this Final Judgment are applicable to defendant, its subsidiaries and divisions, and any agent, employee, representative and all persons, partners, corporations, or other entities acting by, through, under, or on behalf of defendant and all persons in concert with or participating with said defendant with actual or constructive knowledge of this injunction, only insofar as they are doing business in the State of California and confined to defendant's business operations in the County of STANISLAUS and throughout the State of California.
- 3. Pursuant to Business and Professions Code § 17203, Defendant must comply with the following conditions:
 - a) Defendant shall not commit any environmental offenses or violate any environmental statutes, including but not limited to §25299 of the Health and Safety Code; and
 - b) Defendant shall submit proof of January through May, 2005 Designated Operator Inspection forms within fourteen (14) days of the filing of this injunction.
- Defendant shall pay the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS
 (\$20,000.00) in civil penalties to be paid as follows:
 - a) Defendant shall pay the sum of TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000.00),

as civil penalties, including partial cost recovery, pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25299. This civil penalty amount shall be made payable to the <u>Stanislaus County</u> <u>Treasurer Department of Environmental Resources</u>. This penalty is **STAYED** on the condition that Defendant complies with the terms outlined in Section 3(b).

- 5. Defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) in civil penalties to be paid as follows:
 - a) Defendant shall pay FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) as civil penalties, including partial cost recovery, pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25299. This civil penalty amount shall be made payable to the <u>Stanislaus County Treasurer Department of Environmental Resources</u>. These penalties shall be **STAYED** for a period of one (1) year, beginning with the filing of this Stipulated Judgment, on the condition that no violations occur pursuant to this agreement. It is understood that this stayed \$5,000.00 portion of the civil penalty shall immediately be due and owed on this case if any future violations occur. If no violations occur during the one-year period, the stay will become permanent.
- 6. In addition, defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$500.00) to a Supplemental Environmental Program, and/or Recovery Costs, as follows:
 - a) Defendant shall pay the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), payable to the <u>Secretary of the California Environmental Protection Agency</u>. This money shall be deposited into the Environmental Enforcement and Training Account established by Assembly Bill 2486 (2002, Keeley) under the authority of Penal Code § 14301.

- b) Defendant shall pay the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200), payable to the <u>Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources</u>. Such money is to be used for environmental offenses to conduct investigation, prosecution and remediation.
- c) Defendant shall pay the sum of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200), payable to the <u>California State Water Resources Control Board State Water and Pollution Cleanup</u> and Abatement Account.
- 7. Defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS AND THIRTY CENTS (\$580.30) payable to the <u>Stanislaus County Superior Court for filing fees.</u>
- 8. Defendants waive all objections to, employees from the CSWRCB and the Department of Environmental Resources, entering upon their business operations in Stanislaus, CA, for the purpose of inspection and enforcement of the terms of this agreement.
- 9. All checks shall be sent to the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office, attention: Donna Robinson, Stanislaus County Courthouse, P.O. Box 442, Modesto, CA 95353. All amounts, except the filing fee, are due within sixty (60) of the filing of this Final Judgment. The filing fee is due with the signed Stipulated Judgment.
- 10. This Judgment shall go into effect immediately upon entry hereof. Entry is authorized immediately upon filing.
