Plaintiff, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, having filed their complaint herein, JAMES C. BRAZELTON, District Attorney of Stanislaus County, by and through GLORIA M. MAS, Deputy District Attorney of Stanislaus County, and defendant EMANUEL MEDICAL CENTER (DBA), hereby stipulate and consent to the entry of the Permanent Injunction and Final Judgment Pursuant to Stipulation. By signing this stipulation, these named defendants hereby admit the allegations of the complaint. This stipulation is entered into based in part on representations made and reaffirmed by these named defendants herein, that certain penalty payments will be made according to the terms of the Stipulated Final Judgment. This Stipulated Final Judgment shall constitute evidence of admission or concession by these named defendants regarding all allegations of law and fact alleged



1	in the complaint on file herein.		
2	Upon the consent of the parties hereto, and it appearing to the court that there is good cause for		
3	the entry of this Stipulated Final Judgment,		
	IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:		
5	1. This court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and each of the parties		
6	hereto.		
. 7	2. The injunctive provisions of this Final Judgment are applicable to defendants, its		
8 subsidiaries and divisions, and any agent, employee, representative and all persons, par			
9	corporations, or other entities acting by, through, under, or on behalf of defendants and all persons in		
10	concert with or participating with said defendants with actual or constructive knowledge of this		
11,	injunction, only insofar as they are doing business in the State of California and confined to defendants'		
12	dairy operations in the County of STANISLAUS and throughout the state of California.		
13	3. Pursuant to Business and Practice Code §17206, Defendants are hereby permanently		
14	enjoined from:		
15	a) Violating any environmental offenses, including but not limited to §25299 of the Health		
16	and Safety Code.		
17	4. Defendants shall pay the sum of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS		
18	(\$2,500.00) in civil penalties to be paid as follows:		
19	a) Defendants shall pay TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$2,500.00),		
20	as civil penalties, including partial cost recovery, pursuant to Business and Professions Code		
21	§17206. This civil penalty amount shall be made payable to the Stanislaus County Treasurer		
22	Department of Environmental Resources.		
23	These penalties shall be STAYED for a period of three (3) years, beginning the filing of this		
24	Stipulated Judgment, on the condition that no further violations occur pursuant to this		
25	agreement. It is understood that this stayed \$2,500.00 portion of the civil penalty shall		
26	immediately be due and owed on this case if any future violations occur as described in section		



1	3a.	If no violations occur during the three year period, the stay will become permanent.
2		
3	5.	In addition, defendants shall pay the sum of TWO THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED
4	DOLLARS	(\$2,500.00) to a Supplemental Environmental Program, and/or Recovery Costs, as follows:
5		
6	a)	Defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), payable to
7	ř	the Secretary of the California Environmental Protection Agency. This money shall
8	7	be deposited into the Environmental Enforcement and Training Account established
9		by Assembly Bill 2486 (2002, Keeley) under the authority of Penal Code 14301.

11	b)	Defendant shall pay the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00), payable to
12		the Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources. Such money is to be
13	,	used for environmental offenses to conduct investigation, prosecution and remediation.
14		
15	c)	Defendant shall pay the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00),
16		payable to the California State Water Resources Control Board.
17		
18	6.	Additionally, Defendant shall pay the sum of FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY DOLLARS
19	ANI	THIRTY CENTS (\$580.30) payable to the Stanislaus County Superior Court for filing
20	fees.

22	7.	Defendants waive all objections to, employees from the CSWRCB and the Department
23	of Environm	nental Resources, entering upon their business operations, in Stanislaus, CA, for the
24	purpose of in	aspection and enforcement of the terms of this agreement.

26	8.	All checks shall be sent to the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office, attention:
27	Donna Robii	nson, Stanislaus County Courthouse, P.O. Box 442, Modesto, CA 95353. All amounts,



1	except the filing fee, are due within sixty (60) of the filing of this Final Judgment. The filing fee is			
2	due with the signed Stipulated Judgment.			
3	3 8. This Judgment shall go into effect immediately u	pon entry hereof. Entry is authorized		
4	4 immediately upon filing.
