Plaintiff, THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, having filed their complaint herein, CAROL SHIPLEY, Assistant District Attorney for the County of STANISLAUS, by and through Matthew C. Maclear, Deputy District Attorney of Stanislaus County, and defendant HARVEY RIDENHOUR, hereby stipulate and consent to the entry of the Permanent Injunction and Judgment Pursuant to this stipulation. By signing this stipulation, this named defendant hereby admits the allegations of the complaint. This stipulation is entered into based in part on representations made and reaffirmed by the named defendant herein, that certain penalty payments will be made according to the terms of this Stipulated Judgment. This Stipulated Final Judgment shall constitute evidence of admission or concession by this named

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defendant regarding all allegations of law and fact alleged in the complaint on file herein.

STIPULATED JUDGMENT FOR INJUNCTION, CIVIL PENALTIES, AND OTHER RELIEF

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Upon the consent of the parties hereto, and it appearing to the court that there is good cause for the entry of this Stipulated Judgment,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. This court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and each of the parties hereto.

2. The injunctive provisions of this Judgment are applicable to defendant, his agents, employees, representatives and all persons, partners, corporations, or other entities acting by, through, under, or on behalf of defendant and all persons in concert with or participating with said defendant with actual or constructive knowledge of this injunction, insofar as they are doing business in the State of California and confined to defendant's business operations in the County of STANISLAUS and throughout the State of California.

3. Pursuant to Business and Practice Code section 17203, Defendant is hereby required to:

- a) Abide by any and all environmental laws, including but not limited to section
  25299 of the Health and Safety Code, and sections 2672(e), 2729 and 2729.1 of
  the California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 3, Chapter 16, Articles 11
  and 12.
- b) Assign his rights as the responsible party to cleanup funds paid by the State of California to Jon Powers, current owner of record of the property located at 22160 Highway 33, Crows Landing, CA 95313. This assignment of rights by Harvey Ridenhour to Jon Powers shall occur no later July 15, 2006.

4. Defendants shall pay the sum of THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000.00) in civil penalties to be paid as follows:

a) Defendants shall pay THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000.00), as civil penalties, including partial cost recovery, pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 25299. This civil penalty amount shall be made payable to the <u>Stanislaus County Treasurer</u>

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7. Defendants waive all objections to employees from the California State Water Resources Board, CSWRCB, and the Stanislaus County Department of Environmental Resources from entering upon their business operations in the State of California, for the purpose of inspection and enforcement of the terms of this agreement.

 All checks shall be sent to the Stanislaus County District Attorney's Office, attention: Donna Robinson, Stanislaus County Courthouse, P.O. Box 442, Modesto, CA 95353, (209) 558-8563. By September 1, 2006, defendant will pay FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS
 (\$5,000.00), and then will pay ONE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED ELEVEN DOLLARS AND ELEVEN CENTS (\$1,111.11) on the first of each month thereafter, starting October 1, 2006. The final payment due no later than March 1, 2008.

9. This Judgment shall go into effect immediately upon entry hereof. Entry is authorized immediately upon filing.
