NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT WITH JESUS HOLGUIN

FOR ALLEGED VIOLATIONS ASSOCIATED WITH WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY OPERATIONS

WRITTEN COMMENTS DUE NO LATER THAN
5:00 P.M., February 16, 2014

On or after February 16, 2014, the State Water Resources Control Board, (State Water Board) or its delegee will consider approval of a proposed settlement with the Dublin San Ramon Services District to resolve an alleged violation associated with its operation of the Dublin San Ramon Services District Wastewater Treatment Plant. Specifically, the alleged violation involves an employee operating the treatment plant without holding a valid and unexpired operator certification.

The Dublin San Ramon Services District and the Prosecution Team have entered into a tentative settlement for this alleged violation, and have agreed to jointly seek the State Water Board's approval of that settlement through the adoption of a Stipulated Administrative Civil Liability Order.
